The CAP Cadet must have:

- Earned the General Billy Mitchell Award
- Solo wings in a powered aircraft
- At least a 3.0 GPA (normalized on a 4.0 scale)
- Not received or been selected for a similar scholarship or grant (not including solo scholarships)
